## WELCOME:

The Organizing Committee are glad to invite you and your club to participate in the [Vega trophy 1st International Competition](#). The Organizers reserve the right to change the date, location, and program of the competition. When submitting an entry all competitors acknowledge that due to the COVID-19 pandemic situation and public health issues the Organizers can only host the competition in accordance with the effective medical and government regulations and has the solemn right to cancel the competition at any time or to host it between closed doors with a limited number of competitors and no spectators. The competitors also acknowledge that in case laws forbid it the Organizers are unable to hold the competition. Furthermore, in case the competition cannot take place due to legal restrictions or public health issues the Organizers bear no responsibility for any damage resulting from the cancellation and thus no claims can be made towards the Organizers. The Organizers are not obliged to assign a new date for the competition if it is cancelled because of the above-mentioned reasons. The competitors acknowledge that upon cancellation of the competition they do not have the right to claim back the already paid entry fee as the Organizers had various costs concerning the competition.

## GENERAL:

The [Vega trophy 1st](#) will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2025/2026, the Special Regulations and Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2025/2026, and the relevant ISU Communications. Participation in the [Vega trophy 1st](#) is open to all Competitors who belong to an ISU Member, and qualify with regard to eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3. a) and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2526 or any update of this Communication. In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU General Regulations and ISU Communication 2526 all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate. Passports of all Skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must be presented at the accreditation of the event for verification. All competitors must be entered through their respective ISU Member Federation. Clubs registered at ISU Members Federations can participate in competition or Invited clubs ONLY. The OC can have a final design about over quota for any club/country/federation or refuse to accept the entry (full or partially). ## NOTICE:

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to postpone, change the venue or cancel the competition if due to the Coronavirus (Covid-19) the decision of the national Government will not agree to conduct such an event. Also please notice that due to recommendations at the time of the event there could be some restrictions regarding the movements within the arena, a hygienic concept (face masks, hand disinfection etc.) or the distance between each individuals, the teams, the viewers, and guests.

Youngsters: Chicks A, Chicks Axel, Pre-Chicks A Boys and Girls Senior B, Junior B, Novice B, Springs B, Cubs B, Chicks B. Men, Women / Boys, Girls Pre-Chicks B, Chicks C, Pre-Chicks C, Beginners, Hobby class and Adults. Elements Men, Women / Boys, Girls. According to elements technical data season 2025-2026

## ENTRIES

All the members of ISU and Clubs, being members of National Skating Federations associated with ISU, are invited to take part in this competition. Members can enter any quantity of Skaters into each category.

Organizers have the right to refuse or limit the participation in competition.

Entries have to be made before the deadline by filling the Online Registration Form. The Online Registration Form is accessible here: [www.amberskate.lt](http://www.amberskate.lt) (registration) <https://amberskate.lt/vega-trophy-registration> , Upon **to completing the Entry form please upload your competition music** (in MP3 format) (see Paragraph 9. Music). Entry have to be filled in by **December 19th, 2026**. All participants in the competition must have a health certificate confirming they are fit to participate in their chosen competition and sports activities without restrictions, in accordance with Article 17(1) of the Law on Sport of the Republic of Lithuania. By filling out this form, you confirm that all the athletes you have registered possess a valid health certificate and that you will be able to provide it if required. By completing the participant's form, you consent to the disclosure of the participant's personal data on websites and other platforms as necessary for identifying the participant and publicizing the competition results. In addition, by submitting this form, you agree to the participant being filmed and/or photographed, with the possibility of these images being published on websites and other platforms.

Please note! Skaters who did participate in group A, B or C are not allowed to change Category for lowest during season (only with some exceptions consulting with referee and OC), Acting against this rules can cause the cancellation of the competition's results of athlete by oc or the referee of event. It is not allowed to change the skaters category after deadline and after entries are published. You can replace one skater for another only in same category. You can make changes in same category not later than 1 day before draw.

### 6.2. Deadlines of entries

All entries (Competitors and Judges) are expected not later than December 19, 2026.

## ENTRIES OF JUDGES

Each participating ISU Members or Clubs are welcome to nominate one Judge and one substitute Judge with at least the qualification “National Judge” and preferably “International Judge”. Should there be more Judges entered than needed in competition, the Organizing Committee reserves the right to conduct a pre-draw of the panels of Judges. Judges not drawn will be informed in time before the competition.

## LIABILITY

In accordance with ISU Rule 119, the Organizer and the ISU accept no liability for bodily or personal injury, or for property loss or damage incurred by Competitors and Officials. Each ISU Member is expected to provide its own insurance protection for the Officials and Competitors.

## MUSIC

All Competitors are requested to add their competition music (in MP3 format) during the registration by filling the Online Entry Form, which is available here: [www.amberskate.lt](http://www.amberskate.lt) **other way you can't complete the entry form!** The music has to be of excellent quality in MP3 format and named with Competitor's first name, family name, category and segment (eg. name\_surname\_senior\_sp).

In addition Competitors must have a back-up USB flash drive for each program during the competition.

The Organizer assumes no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage incurred in connection with the event mentioned above.

Please note – livestream video and photography is provided during all the event.

## THE CODE OF ETHICS:

All the skaters, coaches, judges, chaperons should follow the ISU Communication 2641, (or any update of this Communication). Action against this rule conducts by itself the disqualification of the skater.

## EXPENSES

Competitors and all other Team Members are responsible for their own travel, accommodation and meal expenses.

## ARRIVAL OF PARTICIPANTS/TEAMS

The nearest airport is Vilnius International Airport (VNO) with a distance of 50 km or Kaunas International Airport with a distance of 55 km to the venue. Please be aware that the Organizing Committee does not provide any transportation from the Airport for the participating teams.

## GALA EVENT

On Sunday, after the competition programs have ended, there will be a Gala event in which the first-place winners of the Skating Federation Grand Prix Stage 2 will have the right to perform. If any of the first-place winners decline to participate, this right may be passed on to the second- or third-place winner.
